THE FULL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. *The subject for the Plymouth: Your 20th Century City competition is the 20th Century Architecture and Built environment of Plymouth. The theme is open to individual interpretation but entries must have the important 20th Century Architecture and Built Environment of Plymouth at heart. We are looking for images of all 20th century buildings, landscape, art, in and around the centre of Plymouth, in particular:*
 - a. *The City Centre itself*
 - b. *Armada Way and its various buildings including Dingles, Royal Bank of Scotland*
 - c. *The Civic Centre, the buildings and landscape around it*
 - d. *Tinside Lido*
 - e. *Buildings around Derry's Cross, including the Theatre Royal*
 - f. *Old Town Street*
 - g. *Various buildings along Notte Street, both religious and non-religious*
 - h. *Guildhall and St Andrews Church*
 - i. *Former Western Morning News Building, New George Street*
 - j. *Pannier Market*
 - k. *Braille Gardens*
 - l. *Plymouth Naval Memorial on the Hoe.*
2. *All images entered must be taken outdoors*
3. *Competition is open to all. Entrants can only submit their photographs via email to competition@acdandc.org.uk, the email should be titled Plymouth: Your 20th Century City Competition. Each entry should be marked with name, email address, a short positive comment on what Plymouth means to them, and where the photo was taken. Each email should not exceed 5mb, multiple emails from one entrant are acceptable.*
4. *Image files must be 300dpi and a maximum of 3 mb. We regret that we are unable to accept postal entries.*
5. *The competition closes at midnight on Tuesday 3rd November 2009 and the organisers accept no responsibility for entries lost, damaged or delayed.*
6. *All entries will be judged by a panel of judges which, in their opinion, best illustrate the theme of the competition. The winners work will be selected to appear throughout the Heritage Lottery Funded Plymouth: 20th Century City project. The winners may be required to take part in publicity and their name will be published on the Plymouth: 20th Century City website. There is no cash alternative and it cannot be sold or transferred. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.*
7. *All images submitted must be the original work of the individual submitting them. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws.*
8. *Entrants will retain copyright in the photographs that they submit to Architecture Centre Devon and Cornwall (ACD&C). By entering the competition all entrants grant to ACD&C the right to publish and exhibit their photographs and on all work and resources relating to Plymouth: 20th Century City, including both Plymouth: 20th Century City and ACD&C's website. Entrants whose photographs are selected to appear in the Plymouth: 20th Century City project above grant to ACD&C the further rights to publish and exhibit their photographs in print, on their respective websites or in any other media. No fees will be payable for any of the above uses. While we make every effort to credit photographers, including in printed reproductions of their work, we cannot guarantee that every use of the photographs will include the photographers' names..*
9. *The ACD&C reserves the right to cancel this competition or alter any of the rules at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.*
10. *All information detailing how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.*
